

ORDINANCE NO. 364

An Ordinance to repeal and replace Chapter 126 of the Bessemer City Code titled Traffic and to Repeal Ordinance 348 titled Uniform Traffic Code.

The City of Bessemer Hereby Ordains:

Parking Lots

No person shall park any motor vehicle in any parking lot or structure other than within the boundaries of the space designated as allocated for the parking of a single motor vehicle by appropriate lines or other markings. Any person parking any motor vehicle in any parking lot or structure otherwise than as prescribed in this section shall be guilty of a violation of this division.

Winter Parking

It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle to park the same or to allow the same to be parked or left standing upon any of the public streets or alleys of the City of Bessemer between the hours of two o'clock AM and six o'clock AM between the first day of November and the thirty-first day of March of the next year.

Other Signs

It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle to disobey parking signs installed by the City of Bessemer.

Uniform Traffic Code

The Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages as promulgated by the director of the Michigan department of state police pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328 and made effective October 30, 2002, and all future amendments and revisions to the Uniform Traffic Code when they are promulgated and effective in this state are incorporated by reference.

References in Code

References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages to a "governmental unit" shall mean the City of Bessemer.

Violations

All violations not otherwise specified shall be municipal infractions punishable by up to \$500. Each day of violation is a separate offense.


