- The boards walked around the park and analyzed the condition of our assets.
- The workout equipment installed during the latest funding round was in good shape. As was the Little League Field, volleyball court
- Many items needed a coat of paint including the benches by the pond, animal bobbles, wooden play set, twirly slide, middle bridge (paint and a few boards replaced).
- The Path could be weeded and raked.
- Several trees around the park can be removed.
- Outhouse could be cleaned and painted
- RC Track is in good shape but could be swept off
- Trail could use more gravel
- Water Building needs the plaster scraped off, brick tuckpointed, painted, and windows fixed (possibly shuttered).
- The basketball court could be seal coated.
- Find out if people use the tennis courts and if lights work
- Sit-up platform can be removed.
- Pond could use some more trees
- Playground can be raked
- 3<sup>rd</sup> bridge by pond needs to be removed.
- Engine needs an updated sign, something to keep birds out, concrete under it fixed, and rust removed
- A tire swing could be installed.
- One swing chains need to be replaced.
