

**A regular meeting of the Planning Council for the City of Bessemer
was held in the City Hall Council Chambers on
Tuesday, April 2nd, 2019 at 6:00**

Osier called the meeting to order at 6:00.

Beninghouse made a motion to accept the minutes and place them on file. Miskovich seconded it and it passed unanimously.

The commission continued the discussion on zoning updates recommended as part of Enabling Better Places.

The commission discussed Ordinance No. 371 about regulating storage containers. The commission had a few alterations. Other prepared pads could be allowed if designed to prevent rust, shipping containers could be allowed in the front yard if in an inconspicuous place, and the restriction on number of shipping containers and stacking was removed. A public hearing will be at the next meeting.

The commission discussed plywood vs clearboarding. No motions were made.

During the Public Comment period, Bill McDonald inquired about a house on US-2 next to St Vinnys that has a collapsed foundation.

Beninghaus made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Miskovich seconded it and it passed unanimously
