


Contract for the construction of Welcome Signs


This is a contract between the City of Bessemer's Downtown Development Authority, hereinafter referred to as "DDA" and Doug Kikkebusch, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor."

In exchange for \$15,000, half to be paid upfront, the Contractor agrees to construct two (2) Welcome Signs per the drawings approved by the DDA. The completed signs will each be 11 feet by 15 feet with the sign face being 4'9" feet by 14'6" feet and the bases 6 feet by 15 feet. The two bases are square 3.5 feet on each side. The Contractor agrees to print the City's colored logo and install it on the face of the sign. The logo will take up a minimum of 90% of the sign's face. The base of the signs will be constructed of Corten Steel and designed to rust without losing structural integrity. The Contractor will be responsible for the installation of the Be Bessemer sign as well.

The DDA is responsible for the installation of the signs including the concrete base and lighting. The Contractor will deliver the finished Welcome Signs ready for installation by October 1st.
