Bid of _____ (hereinafter called "BIDDER"), organized and existing under the laws of the State of _____ doing business as _____ *, to the CITY OF BESSEMER (hereinafter called "OWNER").

In compliance with your Advertisement for Bids, BIDDER hereby proposes to perform all work for the construction of Pulverizing and HMA Paving Services in accordance with the Contract Documents, within the time set forth herein, and at the prices stated below.

1. NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Bidding Instructions

The intent of the bid is to pulverize and repave a section of Colby Hill Rd. All work described below (including Measurement and Payment) shall be as described in the MDOT "2012 Standard Specifications for Construction" (Standard Specifications), except as modified herein.

2. DESCRIPTION OF WORK

HMA Base Crushing and Shaping

Contractor is responsible for pulverizing, shaping, watering and compaction.

HMA Surface Remove

HMA Surface Remove shall be limited to paved driveways and intersections within the limits of the project. Foreman shall mark the drives for saw cut in order to provide a better transition to the proposed roadway elevation.

HMA, LVSP

The work shall consist of HMA, LVSP as shown in the typical sections. The work shall begin at Station 0+00 and run the entire length of the project. The work shall be completed in accordance with section 501 of the Standard Specifications for Construction. Refer to Special provision for Local Paving Project as attached.

1. For mainline paving projects – HMA application rate shall be two lifts at 165#/syd each (330# per syd total) paid by tons.
2. For overlay projects – HMA application rate shall be single lift at 220#/syd total paid by tons.
3. Performance Grade Asphalt shall be PG 52-34
4. Air Voids per MDOT Special Provision for Local Agency Projects 12SP-501J-05.

HMA, Approach

The work shall consist of HMA, Approach for paved intersections and driveway along project. The work shall be completed in accordance with section 501 of the Standard Specifications for Construction. Driveways shall be paved in Two (2) course at depth equal to existing but no greater than 3 inches total.

Maintaining Traffic, Minor Traffic Devices, Traffic Regulator Control, and Signage

Contractor shall be responsible for maintaining traffic, minor traffic devices, traffic regulator control and signage for the Contractor operation. Advance warning signage shall be in accordance with MDOT specification for lane closure or as agreed upon by the Engineer and Contractor. Traffic Regulator Control shall be provided during the operation of work with minor traffic devices used during construction and after working hours to provide safe travelable roadway for the public.

3. PROGRESS CLAUSE

In no case, shall any work be commenced prior to receipt of formal notice of award by the department.

Completion Dates

All projects shall be completed in its entirety on or before **October 15, 2019**.

The approved low bidder(s) for the work covered by this proposal will be required to participate in a pre-construction meeting with local agency owner and/or department representatives to work out a progress schedule.

The owner will arrange the time and place for the meeting.

4. METHOD OF MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Measurement and payment shall be on the basis of the measured square yard, load ticket tonnage or lump sum quantities. The contractor shall measure the area with the owner and submit an invoice for agreed quantity upon completion of all work.

5. BID DEADLINE

Sealed bids for the Colby Hill Rd Project will be received by the City of Bessemer, Clerk's Office at 411 S Sophie, Bessemer, MI 49911 until **11:00 A.M., central time on Wednesday, August 28th, 2019**. All bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud at said office at that time.

6. INSURANCE

The Contractor shall not commence any work until they have obtained and provided a current Certificate of Insurance.

The Contractor shall carry "Public Liability Insurance" coverage to insure the Road Commission against claims arising out of negligence of the Contractor. The insurances shall meet all requirements as shown:

A. WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE

The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of this contract, Workman's Compensation insurance for all of his employees employed at the site of the project and in case work is sub-contracted, the Contractor shall require the sub-contractor similarly to provide Workman's compensation insurance for all of the latter employees unless such employees are covered by the protection afforded by the Contractor.

The BIDDER agrees to perform all described work in the Contract Documents for the following lump sum prices. The BIDDER further agrees that the unit and/or lump sum prices include the furnishing of all labor, materials, tool, equipment, utilities, transportation, taxes, fees, etc., required to complete the work in strict accordance with the Contract Documents.

The BIDDER declares that he/she has carefully examined the Contract Documents for the Project. The BIDDER declares, by submission of the Bid that the Bid is made according to the provisions and under the terms of the Contract Documents, which Contract Documents are hereby made part of the Bid.

The BIDDER agrees that this Bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receiving Bids.

By submission of this Bid, each party thereto certifies as to his/her own organization, that this Bid has been arrived at independently, without consultation, communication or agreement as to any matter relating to this Bid with any other Bidder or with any competitor.

The Owner reserves the right to reject or accept any bid or all bids or to waive irregularities and to accept any bid that, in the opinion of the Owner, is to the best interest and advantage of the City.

BID SPECIFICS

Colby Hill Rd: adding four (4) inches of 22a gravel to the existing surface area then pulverizing and paving. The section is 825 feet long by 22 feet wide. The City is requesting a lump sum quote for two 1.5 inch layers and a separate lump sum quote for one 2 inch layer.

The City may opt to repave the intersection with Granite St based on bid prices. Please include a unit price per square foot for additional work.
