

**AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 364**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE No. 364 BY ADDING A NEW SECTION WHICH NEW SECTION SHALL BE DESIGNATED AS SEASONAL WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS—FROST LAWS TO SAID ORDINANCE**

**THE CITY OF BESSEMER HEREBY ORDAINS:**

**Seasonal Weight Restrictions—Frost Laws** is added to Ordinance No. 364 (before the “Violations” section) of the City of Bessemer to read as follows:

**Seasonal Weight Restrictions—Frost Laws.** The City of Bessemer hereby adopts the Seasonal Weight Restrictions of the Gogebic County Board of County Road Commissioners, both as to weight restrictions and time frames for the restrictions.

**Additional All Season Road Designations.** In addition to the roads designated by the County as exempt seasonal roads, the roads identified in the attached map will also be included in the “all season road” designation and are thus exempt.

**Exempt Vehicles.** Garbage trucks and school buses are exempt from the restrictions. Other exemptions may be granted based on hardship. Hardship exemptions will be granted only after approval of a request for an exemption by the City Council. Any such request must be in writing and identify the desired time, date, route and nature of the items to be transported, including weight.

**Overriding Timeline.** The City of Bessemer may override the timelines established by the Gogebic County Board of County Road Commissioners by Resolution of the City Council.

**Conflict and Repeal.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

**Effective Date.** The adoption of this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency effecting the public peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall, therefore, be effective immediately upon its adoption.

**Publication.** After its adoption, this ordinance or a summary thereof, as permitted by law, shall be published.


