AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5.12 OF CHAPTER 51 ZONING & PLANNING OF TITLE V OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BESSEMER.


THE CITY OF BESSEMER HEREBY ORDAINS:

CHAPTER 51 ZONING.

5.12 Map. No change in language. The map described herein is amended and changed to depict the following described property from A-1 Single Family Residential to D-1 Industrial, namely:

From the intersection of Colby Street and the Plywood Plant access Road, South along the West side of the Access Road to the southern boundary of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T47N, R46W, then East along the $\frac{1}{4}$ section line to the Western edge of the Colby Plat, then along the Colby Plat in a southerly direction to Old County Road, then along the West side of the Old County Road to the north boundary of the Yale Plat, then west along the Yale Plat to the West side of Florence Street, then south on Florence Street to the Northern boundary of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 16 T47N, R46W, then South along the said boundary to the Southern City Limits, then West along the city limit line to the Western City Limits, then North along the Western city limits line to Colby Street, then East along the South side of Colby Street to the Plywood Plant Access Road. Except for the following: (The NE of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17) and from the SW corner of NW-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16 running SE to where Florence Street intersects the Northern boundary of the Yale Plat, then South on Florence Street to Eli Avenue, then West to Western boundary of NW-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, then North to Point of Beginning.

Adopted and approved by the City Commission of the City of Bessemer, Michigan, this 4th day of April, 1988. This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication as required by law. This Ordinance applies to the above described premises, and a copy of it may be inspected or purchased at the City Clerk's office in the Bessemer City Hall, Bessemer, Michigan, during usual business hours.
