

ORDINANCE NO. 285

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY BUILDING INSPECTOR TO ISSUE AND SERVE APPEARANCE TICKETS FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE BUILDING CODE.

An ordinance to amend the Code of the City of Bessemer by adding the new section 8.3a of Chapter 98 of Title VII of said Code.


The City of Bessemer Ordains:

8.3a Appearance Tickets


1. The Bessemer City Building Inspector is authorized by Ordinance to issue and serve appearance tickets upon persons who are construction or building code violators if the Building Inspector has reasonable cause to believe that the person has committed a building code violation.
2. An appearance ticket means a complaint or written notice issued and subscribed by the Building Inspector authorized by law to issue it, directing a person to appear in the 98th District Court for the County of Gogebic at a designated future time in connection with his or her alleged violation of the Building Code for which the maximum permissible penalty does not exceed 90 days in jail and a fine of \$500.00. The appearance ticket shall be numbered consecutively, be in such form as determined by the City Council and the 98th District Court shall consist of the following parts:
 - a. The original which shall be a complaint or notice to appear by the City Building Inspector and filed with the Court.
 - b. The first copy which shall be the abstract of court record.
 - c. The second copy which shall be retained by the Building Inspector.
 - d. The third copy which shall be delivered to the alleged violator.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication, as required by law.
