

CITY OF BESSEMER
ORDINANCE NO. 291

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BESSEMER BY ADDING NEW SECTIONS WHICH NEW SECTIONS SHALL BE DESIGNATED AS 2.250a and 2.254 OF CHAPTER 25 OF TITLE II OF SAID CODE.


CITY OF BESSEMER ORDAINS the following new sections are added to Chapter 25 of Title II of 2.250a and 2.254.

- 2.250a Rates and Charges. In addition to amounts established for the sale of bags as provided by this chapter, the City may establish rates and charges on a monthly or other periodic basis, for collection, or operation of its solid waste disposal system. Such charges shall constitute a lien on the premises to which service is provided and shall be collected in the manner provided by law or this code in the same general manner as liens for water and sewer service or city taxes.
- 2.254 Commercial and Industrial Users. All commercial and industrial users of more than 5 30-gallon city bags per week shall be required to use a dumpster service. All refuse, garbage or solid waste of such users shall be disposed of through a dumpster, either by contract with the City or other private hauler.
- 2.255 Methods of Collection. The City shall have the absolute right of methods of collection. No other methods of collection, other than those authorized by resolution of the City Council or this Ordinance shall be utilized.
- 2.256 Rules for Commercial and/or Industrial Rates. The City shall establish rules for commercial and/or industrial solid waste pickup and rates for the same by resolution of the City Council.
- 2.257 Dumpster Rates. Rates and charges for dumpster service provided by the City shall be established by resolution of the City Council.

Any portions or ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication, as required by law.
