

CITY OF BESSEMER
ORDINANCE NO. 292

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BESSEMER BY REPLACING SECTION 2.244 OF CHAPTER 25 OF TITLE II OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BESSEMER WITH A NEW SECTION 2.244, AND BY AMENDING SECTION 2.242 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BESSEMER.

CITY OF BESSEMER ORDAINS the existing Section 2.244 of the Code of the City of Bessemer is repealed and the following Section 2.244 is adopted in its place:

2.244 Disposal of Refuse; Prohibited in Parks.

- (1) Residential refuse in the City of Bessemer shall be disposed of as follows:
 - (a) All owners or occupants of individual dwelling units, except as provided hereafter, shall utilize the refuse service provided by the City, if available and by the use of City refuse bags, and by adhering to this Chapter;
- (2) No person shall transport refuse to a City park for the purpose of depositing the refuse in trash receptacles located within such park.
- (3) No person shall deposit refuse into any dumpster, container, or receptacle of another person or servicing another dwelling unit or units, or deposit any such refuse upon the property of another person or any public property.

Section 2.242 is amended to read as follows:

- (1) City residential refuse collection service shall be provided to occupants of all dwelling units in the City.

Any ordinances or portions of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication, as required by law.
