

## ORDINANCE NO. 318


AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BESSEMER BY REPEALING SECTION 5.202 OF CHAPTER 52 OF TITLE V, AND REPLACING THE SAME WITH A NEW SECTION 5.202, CHAPTER 52, TITLE V OF THE CODE.

THE CITY OF BESSEMER HEREBY ORDAINS:


The present Section 5.202 of Chapter 52 of Title V of the City Code of the City of Bessemer is hereby repealed and replaced with a new Section 5.202, Chapter 52, Title V, to read as follows:

5.202 Composition; Members; Appointment, Term, Filling Vacancies. The City Plan Commission shall be composed of five, seven, or nine members by Resolution of the City Council, one of whom shall be a member of the legislative body to be selected by resolution of the legislative body to serve as a member ex officio, and the remainder of whom shall represent, insofar as possible, different professions or occupations. The remaining members shall be appointed by the mayor, subject to approval of the city council by majority vote. An appointed member shall not hold another municipal office, except that one appointed member may be a member of the zoning board of adjustment or appeals. The term of each member shall be two (2) years, except that in the case of the first Commission appointed hereunder, two (2) of said members shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year. All such appointments shall date from February 1, 2000. Each member shall hold office until his successor has been appointed. All members of the City Plan Commission, including City employees serving ex officio, shall serve as such without compensation.
