

ORDINANCE NO. 328

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF HOWELL STREET LOCATED BETWEEN LOTS 8 AND 9, BLOCK 4 AND LOTS 1 AND 16, BLOCK 5, ALL IN KARSTE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF BESSEMER, GOGEBIC COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ACCORDING TO THE RECORDED PLAT THEREOF.

WHEREAS; Richard and Cara Matrella petitioned for the vacation of Howell Street between Lots 8 and 9, Block 4 and Lots 1 and 16, Block 5, all in the Karste Addition to the City of Bessemer, Gogebic County, Michigan, according to the recorded plat thereof.

WHEREAS; The City Council, after due consideration of said petition noted above including a duly noticed public hearing regarding same on April 3, 2006, and an affirmative vote to vacate also regarding same, determined that the health, welfare, comfort and safety of the people of the City of Bessemer will be served by vacating that portion of said Howell Street as described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BESSEMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. The vacation of Howell Street located between Lots 8 and 9, Block 4, and Lots 1 and 16, Block 5, all in the Karste Addition to the City of Bessemer, Gogebic County, Michigan, according to the recorded plat thereof, hereby is vacated, and said street so vacated shall vest in the rightful proprietors owning lands adjacent thereto and bordering thereon as shown in the Plat of said Addition.

Section 2. The City Clerk of the City of Bessemer, Michigan is hereby directed within thirty (30) days after the adoption of said ordinance to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the Gogebic County (Michigan) Register of Deeds, and further send a copy of said Ordinance to the State Treasurer of the State of Michigan.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be published pursuant to Section 6.4 of the City Charter, and shall be effective upon recordation with said Register of Deeds pursuant to MCLA 560.256, as amended.
