

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 345

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTIONS 9.78 AND 9.71(3),  
CHAPTER 113, TITLE IX OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BESSEMER

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 273, adopted pursuant to Chapter 1, Title 1 of the City of Bessemer Ordinance Code on July 7, 1986, provided for the prohibition of possession, ownership, keeping or harboring of Pit Bull Terriers within the municipal limits of the City of Bessemer by any person, pursuant to Section 9.78, Chapter 113, Title IX, and


WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 273 adopted a definition of Pit Bull Terriers, pursuant to Section 9.71(3), Chapter 113, Title IX, and

WHEREAS, Gogebic County, Michigan has a county ordinance providing for any police officer, Sheriff's Deputy or Officer authorized by law to provide animal control within the municipal limits of the City of Bessemer,


THE CITY OF BESSEMER HEREBY ORDAINS:

An Ordinance to repeal Sections 9.71(3) and 9.78 is adopted pursuant to Chapter 1, Title 1 of the City of Bessemer Ordinance Code. Such ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
